APPRENTICESHIP ACCUMULATED HOURS PAY-RAISE SCHEDULE

(Schedule applies to all apprentices indentured into the program beginning July, 2007, as per the changes in the Apprenticeship Standards.)

In order for an apprentice to be considered for advancement from one pay period to the next, it will be necessary to have acquired the minimum number of hours shown in the "Accumulated Hours" column opposite the pay period.

NOTE: The accumulation 9000 on-the-job hours does not automatically qualify an apprentice for journeyman status. The J.A.T.C. will evaluate each case and make the determination as to whether or not it will be necessary for the individual to acquire additional on-the-job hours before being considered for journeyman status.
